## TFM North Bay Clean-Up

On July 16, 2005, TFM members completed a massive clean up effort in the North Apparatus Bay at the Texas Fire Museum. Nearly every piece of fire apparatus was moved out and the concrete floors were stripped of the accumulated dirt using high pressure washers. In addition, all the water was drained from the center floor waste trap and then this pit was thoroughly cleaned by removing the grates and shoveling out the years of accumulated dirt. The difference after the cleaning was amazing. Many members had no idea that Dallas Fire Maintenance had painted the North Bay floor with stripes, dividing the 7,500 square foot bay into individual work areas. Once the bay cleaning was completed, all of the apparatus were reorganized and moved back in to maximize our floor space in this area.

Special thanks to all of our many members who volunteered their time to complete this daunting task. Special mention also goes to member David Rounsley, who has now taken on the task to begin painting the interior walls of the North Bay.
