Richardson Restoration Arrives at TFM

On July 8, 2006, The Texas Fire Museum received a 1983 American LaFrance engine for cosmetic restoration from the Richardson, Texas, Fire Department. The restoration entails removal of the existing water tank, lowering the floor supports in the hose bed, adding parade seating, new wood flooring, new upholstery, paint and gold leaf striping and trim. Once finished, this engine will serve as a parade engine and, when required, a funeral coach for the City of Richardson.

We are very pleased to have been awarded the bid to restore this proud piece of history for the fire department. Funding for this project has been provided by the City of Richardson,
